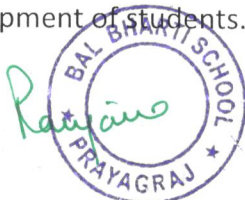
Infrastructure and Facilities

Student Strength

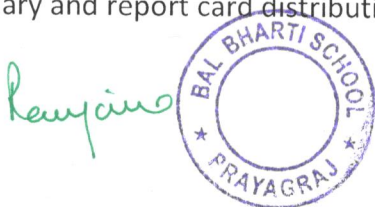
The school witnessed active participation and steady growth in student enrolment during the academic session.

Physical fitness and sportsmanship remain an integral part of school education. Students participated enthusiastically in various indoor and outdoor games including:

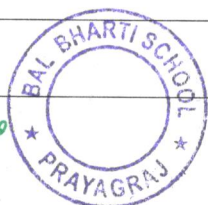
